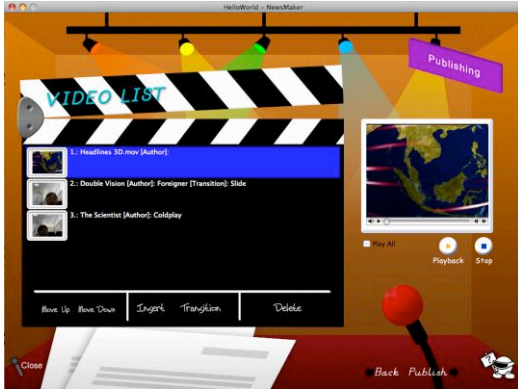


Step 3: Publishing - What you can do here

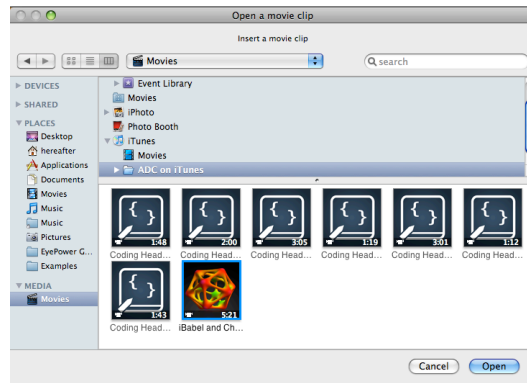


You can do the following:

1. [Insert video clips from external sources](#)
2. [Delete a video entry](#)
3. [Arrange the video in the desired sequence](#)
4. [Insert transition effects](#)
5. [Preview](#)
6. [Publish](#)

Insert video clips from external sources

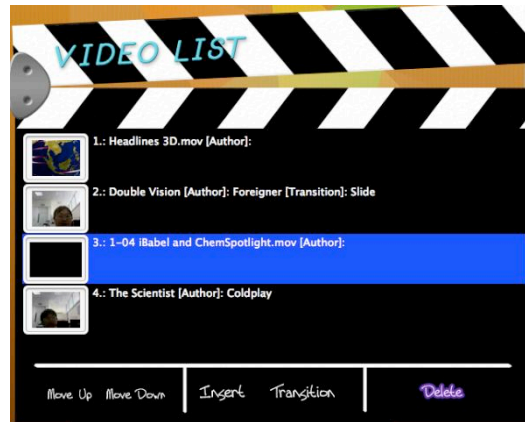
1. Click on the Insert button to insert a video clip from an external source.
2. Select the desired video file on the PC and click Open. The video will be shown on the Video List.



Delete a video entry

1. To delete a video entry on the Video List, select the video and click the Delete button. You will be prompted before the file is removed from the Video List.

NOTE that the file is not physically deleted from the Mac if it is an external video..



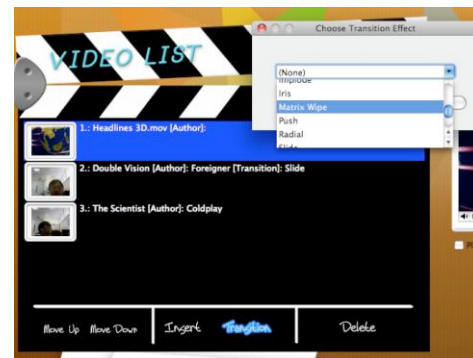
Arrange the video in the desired sequence

1. To arrange the video in the desired sequence, select to highlight the video on the Video List. Then click “Move Up” or “Move Down” button to move the video into the desired position.



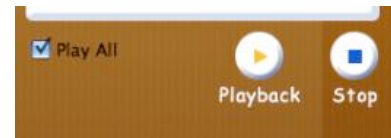
Insert transition effects

1. Transition effect can be attached to any video in the list. To do that, select the top video entry and click on the Transition Effect. The transition effect will be attached to the selected video and it will happen at the end of that video clip..



Preview

1. Every video entry on the Video List can be previewed. Select the video on the Video List and click on the Playback button under the preview screen.
2. You may preview the entire project by checking on the “Play all” box and then click on the “Playback” button.



Publish

1. When everything is in good order, you can then publish your project as a single video file by clicking on the Publish button. Give a filename and choose the directory to publish your project to. During the publication process, all the video entries in the Video List will be merged into a single video file. By default, the video format is MOV. Once the project has been published, the video can be playback using any media player.
